Church history of interest to women

As promised a few weeks ago, below is a short addition to the history of *Generations*.

Girls – of all ages – should get a kick out of seeing the role of women in building this church.

The person who, in 1908, was called the "organizer" of the church was "Evangelist Sister Mason."

On April 13, 1957, Mrs. Lester G. Bixler cited articles from the archives of *The Woods County Enterprise* that noted some activities of the women of the church between 1908 and 1939. The articles cited indicated that:

 in November of 1908, "the ladies of the Christian Church" organized "a society" called "Willing Workers"

- 2) in January of 1909, a "neck tie social" was being planned
- 3) on April 10, 1909: "a fair and another of their good suppers" was to be held.
- 4) on March 12, 1913: "a good social" followed the regular business meeting
- 5) by 1926, the group was called "The Loyal Woman Class"
- 6) A program dated April 3, 1957 – announced the 49th anniversary of the women's "Missionary Society."
- 7) An annual report of 1962-1963 indicated the women's group was referred to as the "CWF."
